



MEALS AT CASA TRES VIDAS "CTV"

- ◇ Your villa room rate includes a personal chef and waiter that will prepare and serve 2 meals per day, 6 days a week (not on Sunday, the staff's day off). Usually breakfast and dinner each day. Breakfast is served between 9:00 am and 10:00 am. Dinner is served between 5:00 pm and 7:30 pm.
- ◇ The Houseman will present your grocery receipts plus a \$12USD convenience/taxi fee daily per Villa, after breakfast, for payment. Please pay **cash** in USD or Pesos for your groceries. We cannot accept credit cards for food and beverage purchases.
- ◇ After breakfast, you will then order for dinner that night and breakfast the next morning. There are suggested menus provided by the chef.
- ◇ CTV keeps an inventory on-site of popular beverages that are frequently requested that may be purchased. Keep in mind that items available in the U.S. are not always available in Mexico. Imported brands will dramatically increase liquor costs.
- ◇ The best value is to order soft drinks, water and beer by the case. You are also welcome to bring in your own drinks or make your own grocery/liquor store run.
- ◇ There is no need to pre-order drinks or food for your entire stay. The staff shops each day and will resupply your villa for the next 24 hours.
- ◇ Food costs depend on what you order. The Mexican plate dinner costs approximately \$10 - 12USD per person while Surf & Turf will run \$21 - 25USD per person. These prices do not include alcohol.
- ◇ Sunday is the staff's day off. There is no food or maid service. If you are arriving on a Sunday, please pre-order through our Food Form the items you would like in your Villa for that day. If you arrive on any other day, please have the staff purchase food items you would like to prepare for Sunday's meals and snacks on Saturday.
- ◇ Pre-ordered food and beverage items must be submitted **10 days prior to arrival**. All orders are sent to the staff prior to your arrival for shopping so modifications, additions or changes are not possible within that 10 days.
- ◇ If you want to go out to dinner one or more nights during your stay, just let the staff know and they can plan their shopping accordingly. The staff can also prepare lunch instead of dinner. You will just need to give the staff more notice, so they can purchase items a day prior to the lunch service.
- ◇ **Monday-Friday arrivals:** your first dinner and breakfast will be a set menu: Mexican dinner plate -- Tortilla Soup, Chicken Enchiladas, Arrachera Steak Tacos, Spanish Rice and Flan. The following morning's menu: Mexican Scrambled Eggs, Bacon, Fried Potatoes, Refried Beans, Toast, Fruit, Orange Juice, Coffee, Tea.
- ◇ **Saturday arrivals:** your first dinner and breakfast will be a set menu served as follows: the Mexican Plate dinner will be served Saturday night and the Mexican breakfast will be served on Monday morning.
- ◇ **Sunday arrivals:** A staff member will greet you and check you in. Your first dinner and breakfast will be a set menu served as follows: The Mexican breakfast and Mexican Plate dinner will both be prepared and served on Monday.
- ◇ Your personal staff should be tipped at the end of your stay. Tips should be given to the House Manager, Sara, to split up between the chefs, waiters, maids, night watchman and pool man. We recommend guests tip \$10 to \$12 per guest per day. For 6 guests in a villa the tip would be between \$60 and \$72 per day. Please pay **cash** in USD or Pesos for your tips. We cannot accept credit cards for tips.
- ◇ Please note we have a surcharge for outside guests not staying at Casa Tres Vidas or Quinta Maria Cortez of \$15USD per person for Dinner and/or \$8USD for Breakfast, not including tip/gratuinity
