TRANSPORTATION

Casa Perezoso is located at 392 Calle Santa Barbara. The easiest mode of transportation from the airport is via taxi. Tell the taxi driver that you are going to a private home right south of the Hotel Almar on Santa Barbara. Casa Perezoso is a Beige Stucco home with big wood doors just south of the Hotel Almar. Taxi fare from the airport to Casa Perezoso is about \$25USD for 1-3 people with luggage. More people with luggage will require 2 taxis or a van.

STAFF

Your maid Tere is there to assist in making your stay at Casa Perezoso an enjoyable one. Tere works approximately 4 hours a day, 6 days a week. Sunday is her day off. Sara Gonzalez is the manager. Feel free to call her if you have any questions about Casa Perezoso. Erik will be there twice a week to clean the jacuzzi and add chemicals. There is a gardener that will be there once a week.

GRATUITIES/TIPPING

Although we recognize that tipping is at the sole discretion of the client, it is a nice way of saying “thanks” for the services rendered any place in the world. The suggested minimum tip per day, per guest is \$8.00 USD. Gratuities can be left on departure day. This daily amount is for weekly stays.

CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT

Check-in is at 2:00 pm. Check-out is at 11:00 am.

WATER

Casa Perezoso has a water purification system. You may drink tap water without problems. We do, however, encourage all guests to drink bottled water during their vacation to be on the safe side.

WI-FI

Casa P has a wi-fi router near the phone in the kitchen, the signal is “CASA P” – the **password is: 322 222 5503** (no spaces, just run together – it is the phone number of the house). Please remember that it is a concrete building so it performs better in the living area.

STEREO/TV/POWER

There is a TV/VCR in the living room. There are 2 remotes for the TV. One for the TV itself & the other for the Fire Stick. You only need to use the remote for the Fire Stick. The TV remote is there just for back up. Your electrical equipment will work fine in Vallarta. There is no need for adaptors.

PHONES

Puerto Vallarta’s phone numbers are 10 digits (same as in the USA/Canada) all starting with 322. The phone number at Casa Perezoso is 322-222-5503. Calls made from the US to Casa Perezoso are dialed: 011-52-322-222-5503. Please call your cellular company prior to departure to activate international capabilities. The phone at Casa Perezoso does not have a block. Phone calls to the US are very expensive. Long distance charges show up on the telephone bill 6-8 weeks after they are made. Please do not make long distance personal calls on the house phone.

KEYS

Tere will be there to greet you and give you key sets. There are additional key sets in the drawer under the clock in the kitchen. **The gate key to the terrace is in the soap dish in the powder room. Please lock the terrace gate if you leave the house - always lock the upstairs gate at night.** Tere is there for your departure and will take care of locking up the house.

TOWELS & LINENS

The Villa is stocked with linens and towels. Please do not take the white bathroom towels to the beach or terrace. Tere will provide you with beach towels upon request. There are also beach towels in the powder room on the main level of the house. Bed linens will be changed twice a week. If you would like fresh towels, please leave them on the floor. If you plan to reuse towels please hang them on the towel bars.

We will email you a Food & Beverage form. Fill it out and return it to us with the goods that you would like stocked in the villa for arrival day. Daniel, the houseman at Casa Tres Vidas will shop for those goods. You will be provided a receipt from the grocery store. Please reimburse him with either Pesos or the US dollar equivalent. We cannot accept credit cards for food and beverage items.

Stores That Our Guests Recommend:

Fruits & Vegetables— Adolfinia Suarez Pena & Lazaro Cardenas #544: Wonderful small fresh vegetable and fruit store. They receive fresh produce every Monday, Wednesday and Friday (open from 4:00am to 5:00pm) on Tuesdays and Saturdays they are open from 6:00am to 5:00pm. On Sundays they are open from 6:00am to 3:00pm. Prices are really good and quality.

Pharmacy—Enrique Diaz de Leon, Insurgentes #261: Open every day, 24 hours. Pharmacy and grocery store

Mexican Bakery—Yarita Panaderia – Basilio Badillo #244: Very inexpensive and all kinds of croissant, muffins, bread. Open Monday thru Saturday from 7:00am to 9:00pm and Sunday 7:00am to 1:00pm.

Fresh fish and seafood - Every morning you have the fishermen selling at the north end of the Malecon.

WHAT TO BRING

Good walking shoes, such as tennis shoes, to walk up and down the street from the house. It is a cobblestone street. Binoculars - If you are lucky enough you might see dolphins.

DEPARTURE DAY

On departure day you can either check with the taxi stand right out front of the Hotel Almar and make arrangements with one of the drivers to take you to the airport or call 322 223-4587. You should plan to leave the house approximately 2 to 2 ½ hours prior to departure.

Don't lose your tourist card. The customs agents at the airport will give you the stub upon arrival. You will have to present it at check-in for departure to the US/Canada. It is expensive and a hassle if you lose it.
